

BARTLEY SECONDARY SCHOOL CCA Policy

CCA IS COMPULSORY

- CCA is an integral part of the student's holistic education in school. Hence, CCA participation is compulsory at the secondary school level.
- Attendance must be above 75%.
- Absence must be accompanied by a MC or parent excuse letter*

• Every Thursday from 3:30PM to 6:00PM.

Additional Training Days

- Mon, Tue, Wed or Fri (To be communicated by respective CCA teachers)
- Weekends (as per requirement for Camps, Competitions etc)






CCA Policy

Changing of CCA

- Sustained engagement in the same CCA allows for progressive development.
- However, if there is a need, students must follow the proper procedure and produce necessary documentation.
 - All requests for change of CCAs must be done through the HOD PE/CCA.
 - All cases will be reviewed on an individual basis.
 - Change in CCA will only be processed at the beginning of a new academic year.

For students who are in Uniformed Group CCA, please note that a change of CCA will not be allowed without a valid medical reason.

- He put Basketball as his 1st Choice during CCA selection but all the students who were successful in the basketball trials placed basketball as their 1st Choice.








CCA Open House: Students will have the chance to see all the available CCA at Bartley Secondary.




