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### **INFORMATION SHEET FOR SECONDARY 1 STUDENTS (2022)**

## 1. REPORTING

- 1.1 Please ensure that your child/ward knows his/her assigned class.
- 1.2 Your child/ward needs to report to the school (main classroom block at Level 4) when the new school term begins on Tuesday, 4 January 2022 by 7.15 a.m.
- 1.3 In line with Safe Management Measures (SMM), please be informed that parents/guardians will only be allowed to drop off their child/ward at school.

### 2. SECONDARY ONE ORIENTATION

- 2.1 There will be an orientation for all Secondary One students on Tuesday, 4 January 2022 and Wednesday, 5 January 2022.
- 2.2 Students will be dismissed at 1.15 p.m. on Tuesday, 4 January 2022 and 2.25 p.m. on Wednesday, 5 January 2022.
- 2.3 Please ensure that your child/ward has sufficient cash and/or food for one 35-min recess break and one 10-min snack break (only finger food allowed, e.g. biscuits, sandwiches, etc is allowed between 1.15 p.m. to 1.25 p.m. from Mondays to Wednesdays while lessons are ongoing).
- 2.4 All students are required to be in Bartley's PE attire (PE T-Shirt & PE Shorts) during the orientation. For students who have yet to receive their orders, they may wear their primary school PE attire.
- 2.5 Things to bring for orientation (and daily)
  - Student organiser & stationery (to jot down any learning and reminders)
  - English storybook (to cultivate good reading habits and be meaningfully occupied)
  - Water bottle (to ensure hygiene for self and others while refilling from water-cooler)
  - Thermometer (to inculcate personal & social responsibility for well-being of self & others)
  - Sufficient cash and/or food

#### 3. SECONDARY ONE PARENT ENGAGEMENT & CCA e-OPEN HOUSE

- 3.1 Secondary One Parent Engagement & CCA e-Open House will be held on **Saturday, 8 January 2022** from 8.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. over a **Zoom session**.
- 3.2 Our Principal will formally address all parents and students at 8.30 a.m. with regards to the life of a secondary school student in Bartley, followed by a CCA briefing.
- 3.3 More details of this e-engagement over Zoom will be made known when school reopens.
- 3.4 It is mandatory for all students to attend the Parent Engagement & CCA e-Open House.
- 3.5 All parents are invited to attend the Parent Engagement & CCA e-Open House.

- 4.2 All CCAs will be conducted every Thursday from 3 p.m.
  - a. CCA Trials and Experience sessions for Secondary 1 students will begin from Term 1, Week 2.
  - b. Details relating to the training days and end time for specific CCAs will be released during the Parent Engagement & CCA e-Open House.
  - c. Any changes with regards to the training day for CCA, and/or additional day(s) of training required will be made known by the respective CCA teacher in-charge.
