





### FACE-TO-FACE ONLINE LESSONS: HOW CAN I PREPARE?



- For live lessons, you will need to ensure that you are ready to join the lesson at the time instructed by your teacher (indicated in the daily plan).
- Ensure that you are in your living room and are appropriately dressed for live lessons.

### FACE-TO-FACE ONLINE LESSONS: HOW CAN I PREPARE?



- Your teacher will share the meeting ID and passcode with you separately.
- To ensure security, do not share the link or passcode of the live meet with others or on any social media platform.
- Pay attention during the lesson and seek clarifications actively. Do not surf other websites unless instructed by your teacher.

### WHAT IF I NEED HELP FOR SUBJECT-RELATED MATTERS?

 For subject related questions, your subject teacher will be available to provide support. (Email address in daily plan)

 Your form teacher or Year Head will also be available to provide additional support.

#### WHAT IF I HAVE PROBLEMS LOGGING IN TO SLS?



- Step 1: Check that you have keyed in your user id correctly
- Step 2: Seek help from your FT
- Step 3: Call school helpdesk at 62889013, specifying you need to reset SLS password. Leave your full name and contact number. SLS admin will get back to you again.

### WHAT IF I HAVE PROBLEMS LOGGING INTO MY STUDENT ICON DASHBOARD

- Step 1: Check that you have keyed in your Student lcon ID correctly [Check with your FT your user ID if you are unsure]
- Step 2: If you are trying to login to your student icon on a mobile device, check that you are using Safari OR Edge browser.
- Step 3: Call school helpdesk at 62889013, specifying you need to reset Student Icon password. Leave your full name and contact number. SLS admin will get back to you again.



We have rolled out Student iCON to your school and **YOU** will be coming on board!

Student iCON is a suite of Google apps that helps to better support your learning and collaboration with others.

#### WHAT IF I HAVE ISSUES WITH MY PLD?

- Step 1: Refresh the Webpage
- Step 2: Restart your Chromebook
- Step 3: Clear your browsing History
- **Step 4**: Take a screen shot of what you see on your screen, Whatsapp the FTs. FTs will inform HOD ICT who will work with DMA vendor on the issue.
