

* Students are allowed to wear PE attire to school on days with PE lessons to avoid intermingling while changing in the toilets in line with Safe Management Measures (SMM).

Plain white canvas shoes and plain white socks (at least 2 fingers above ankle) must be worn.

Mother Tongue Language (MTL)

- Parent/Guardian of child/ward who qualify for Higher Mother Tongue Language will be contacted via email/phone using details provided in the registration form.
- For Express or Normal(Academic) students who want to offer MTL 'B', the following criteria applies
 - AL 7/AL 8 in standard MTL or
 - AL B/AL C in foundation MTL

Subject-based Banding (SBB)

• Parent/Guardian of child/ward who is in the Normal (Academic) or Normal (Technical) streams and are offered Subject-based Banding will be informed via Parents Gateway/phone using details provided in the registration form.

Appeal

- For parents who are appealing to transfer their child out based on <u>medical reasons</u>, please call 9618 9313 to enquire before making a trip to school to submit the necessary documents.
- For parents who are appealing for a place in our school based on <u>non-medical reasons</u>, please use the online link found in this webpage and submit the necessary details.

All application results would only be made known on 4 Jan 2022. Students are to report to their posted school first.

School Smart Card (SSC)

- Students will receive their new Secondary level School Smart Card (SSC) in March 2022 (tentative).
- Meanwhile, your child/ward may still use his/her Primary level SSC for concessionary travel till end April 2022.
- Note that students need to purchase the Bus Concession Pass (BCP) for Secondary School students.

Health & Dental Services

- Health Promotion Board will be conducting health screening, immunisation and providing dental services for your child.
- Your consent is required to ensure your child receives these important health and dental services provided.
- You would need to access an online portal to give your consent. More details are found in the Secondary 1 registration page.

Safe Management Measures (SMM)

- Students are to wear a <u>surgical mask</u> at all times and minimise talking when eating/drinking.
- Students are required to bring their <u>Trace Together token/app</u> to school; it is highly encouraged to have a Trace Together token to facilitate accurate and automatic contact tracing; parents/guardians are to ensure your child's/ward's Trace Together token/app is working.
- Students should continue to <u>wipe down</u> surfaces of common areas, e.g. canteen after use and desks after lessons.
- Students must be <u>socially responsible</u> by being at home if they are unwell and to seek medical treatment immediately. Students are to comply with Isolation Order and Stay Home Notice. Students should test ART negative if issued with Health Risk Warning.


